BACKGROUND: The Amended and Restated Agreement for Management, Operations and Theatrical Production Services for the Lyceum Theatres by and between Horton Plaza Theatres Foundation ("HPTF") and San Diego Repertory Theatre, Inc. ("REP") ("Agreement") was executed by the parties in September 2009 and set forth the terms and conditions under which the REP will manage and operate the Lyceum, produce theatrical presentations at the Lyceum, and provide production assistance services for theatrical presentations presented by other users of the Lyceum. The Agreement was revised and extended on October 22, 2019.

DISCUSSION: The following substantial revisions are proposed to the Agreement:

- Section V.F.2. revises the REP's annual audit report supplement statement to include the following:
 - o Revenue/Income:
 - Management fee income from HPTF
 - Theatre management income from other users (Co-Production)
 - Concessions income
 - Equipment rental income
 - REP production (calculated by number of weeks REP uses Stage and Space Theatres at market rate)
 - Direct expenses associated with the operation of the Lyceum (REP and all other users):

- Front of house expense
- Box office expense
- Production expense (production supervisor and master electrician)

F. <u>Accounting and Financial Records and Reporting.</u>

- 1. <u>Accounting Records</u>. The REP shall, during the term of this Agreement and for a period of three (3) years after its termination, maintain complete and accurate accounting records and systems, utilizing the standard classification of accounts and Governmental Accounting Standards, and supporting documentation for all revenue generated and operating expenses incurred pursuant to this Agreement.
- 2. Annual Audit Reports. Not more than 120 days after the close of its fiscal year, the REP shall submit to HPTF an audited financial statement prepared by an independent certified public accountant for the previous fiscal year. In addition to the financial statement, the REP shall submit an audited supplemental statement that segregates certain operations of the Lyceum from other operations of the REP. The segregated operations to appear in the supplemental statement shall include revenues: management fee from HPTF, theatre management (co-production), concessions, equipment rental, and REP production (calculated by number of weeks REP uses Stage and Space at market rate); and shall include direct expenses associated with operation of Lyceum (Rep and all other users): front of house, box office, production expense (production supervisor and master electrician), facility repair and maintenance, utilities, concessions, FF&E repair and maintenance, and rental bad debt. Within 120 days of the termination of this Agreement, a final report shall be submitted to HPTF covering the period between the last report and the termination date.
- 3. <u>Other Reports</u>. The REP shall provide to HPTF, upon reasonable request, written financial and other reports and access to inspect all operational and financial records and data pertaining to the services provided under this Agreement.

Section VI. Rights and Obligations of the Parties.

- A. <u>Covenants By HPTF.</u> HPTF agrees and covenants that during the term of this Agreement, HPTF shall annually pay the actual cost of property insurance, property taxes and costs required to perform its maintenance obligations as set forth in Exhibit A. HPTF shall have no obligation to pay the cost of any utilities.
- B. <u>Covenants By the REP</u>. The REP agrees and covenants that during the term of this Agreement:
- 1. <u>Season Subscriptions for the REP Theatrical Productions</u>. No more than ninety percent (90%) of the total seats available for any production presented by the REP may be sold to subscribers as part of a season ticket package.
- 2. <u>Annual Schedule of Ticket and Concessions.</u> On or before March 31 of each year, REP shall provide to HPTF a schedule setting forth the prices of tickets and concession items, including beverages, food, confections, novelties and publications to be charged to other users in accordance with Section V.D hereof. The REP shall provide sufficient justification for any proposed increases in the prices of tickets and concessions.
- 3. <u>Annual Schedule of Presentations</u>. The REP understands and acknowledges that HPTF has a corporate responsibility to ensure community access to and effective, efficient utilization of the Lyceum, therefore, on or before March 31 of each year, the REP shall submit to HPTF for its review and comment, an Annual Schedule of Presentations.

HORTON PLAZA THEATRES FOUNDATION ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND PROCEDURE FOR AWARD OF PRODUCTION ASSISTANCE SUPPORT FOR PRODUCTIONS AT THE LYCEUM THEATRES

Horton Plaza Theatres Foundation ("HPTF") has adopted a policy that the Lyceum Theatres is a public theater that will be made accessible to the widest range of users, presenters and audiences, so as to present to the public high quality theatrical productions providing significant and broad cultural enrichment. In furtherance of this policy, HPTF has established a Production Assistance Fund ("PAF") to provide financial assistance to local non-profit theatrical production companies and organizations to encourage and enable these entities to present theatrical performances at the Lyceum Theatres. PAF assistance is intended to:

- promote the presentation of quality artistic productions and maximize the use of the Lyceum;
- · promote productions whose content brings under-served audiences to the Lyceum;
- promote growth of new and/or emerging artistic organizations and groups to increase the variety of disciplines presented in the productions at the Lyceum.
- promote theatrical productions to reach out to youth and diverse communities to attend productions at the Lyceum.

PAF assistance offsets a percentage of the Co-Production Fees charged by the Lyceum's resident managing company, San Diego Repertory Theatre Inc. ("REP").

Eligible Organizations

PAF financial assistance is awarded to eligible organizations that meet the following criteria:

- 1) nonprofit theatrical performing arts organizations located in the County of San Diego that present live artistic performances may apply;
- 2) eligible artistic organizations must have an annual operating budget of less than \$1 million dollars;
- 3) PAF assistance for organizations with annual operating budget in excess of \$1 million dollars requires the approval of the HPTF Board of Directors;
- 4) an organization may receive no more than \$10,000 assistance in a fiscal year;
- 5) PAF assistance will not be considered for any production, which received PAF assistance in the immediately preceding twenty-four (24) months.

Award Criteria

PAF financial assistance is awarded based on need and the following quantitative and qualitative criteria:

1) organization's annual budget is less than \$1 million dollars and the proposed

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production could not be presented without production assistance funding;

- 2) organization and the proposed production will bring in under-served audiences or provide performance opportunities for culturally diverse artists;
- 3) organization and/or the proposed production fosters variety in the artistic disciplines presented at the Lyceum;
- 4) applicant demonstrates the ability to present a quality artistic production.

Application Process

Presenters must submit a written application to the San Diego Repertory Theatre to apply for PAF assistance. Application includes:

- 1) general description of the proposed production and the proposed dates;
- 2) budget for the production and all sources of funding for the production;
- 3) amount of assistance request;
- 4) copy of the organization's most recent year Form 990;
- 5) copy of the organization's Federal or State Tax Exemption Letter and/or such other evidence demonstrating nonprofit status; and
- 6) copy of the organization's Articles of Incorporation filed with the Secretary of State.

Requirements for Funding

The PAF recipient shall recognize receipt of PAF funding from the City of San Diego in all program materials and the following acknowledgement shall be included in any contract for the award of PAF funding.

Presenter will acknowledge Horton Plaza Theatres Foundation and the City of San Diego in all promotional documents, which shall read as follows:

Name of production is partially funded by the City of San Diego through Horton Plaza Theatres Foundation.

Two copies of all promotional documentation to be submitted to HPTF prior to the release of PAF funding.

Award Notification and Contract for Production

The REP will provide the applicant written notification of its rejection or selection determination within thirty (30) days of receipt of the complete application and all required submittals. Notification of selection and award of PAF funding shall include an estimate of the Co-Production Fees the REP will charge and the percentage of PAF assistance awarded, and a confirmation of the booking dates and the specific theater.

Within thirty (30) days after the notification, the producer must sign a written contract with the REP setting forth all of the terms and conditions associated with the use of the theater for the production.

Appeal Procedure

Any applicant may appeal the REP's decision to deny PAF assistance or the decision on the percentage of PAF assistance awarded. The appeal must be submitted, in writing, to the Horton Plaza Theatres Foundation, P.O. Box 124734, San Diego, CA 92112. The written appeal must clearly state the basis for the applicant's objection to the REP's decision and present any supporting documentation for the relief requested in the appeal. HPTF will render a written decision on the appeal within fourteen (14) days of receipt of all written documentation.

If requested by the applicant, the HPTF board or a committee of the board shall schedule a hearing on the appeal as soon as practicable, but not more than thirty (30) days after receipt of the written appeal. The hearing shall be conducted in accordance with rules and procedures established by HPTF. The decision rendered by HPTF shall be final.

LYCEUM THEATRES INSURANCE REQUIRED

Insurance. Contractor must procure and maintain for the duration of the Contract insurance against claims for injuries to persons or damages to property which may arise from, or in connection with, the performance of the work hereunder and the results of that work by Contractor, his agents, representatives, employees, or subcontractors.

- Required types of Insurance. Contractor must provide at a minimum, the following: 1.
 - Commercial General Liability. Commercial General Liability (CGL) insurance written on A. ISO Form CG 00 01 covering COL on an "occurrence" basis, including products and completed operations, property damage, bodily injury, and personal and advertising injury with limits no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence. If a general aggregate limit applies, either the general aggregate limit will apply separately to this project/location (ISO CG 25 03 or 25 04) or the general aggregate limit must be twice the required occurrence limit.
 - В Commercial Automobile Liability. For all of Contractor's automobiles including owned, hired and non-owned automobiles, Contractor must keep in full force and effect Commercial Automobile Liability insurance written ISO Form Number CA 0001 covering Code 1 (any auto) or, if Contractor has no owned autos, Code 8 (hired) and 9 (nonowned), with limit no less than \$1,000,000 per accident for bodily injury and property damage.

Named insureds reserves the right to require complete, certified copies of all required insurance policies, including endorsements required by these specifications, at any time.

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- Other Insurance Provisions. The insurance policies are to contain, or be endorsed to contain, the following provisions. If any of the provisions, include a limitation to signed contracts, that limitation be removed or endorsements issued that do not include that limitation.
 - A. Additional Insureds Status. City of San Diego, its respective elected officials, officials, employees, agents, and volunteers; City of San Diego, Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, its respective members, officers, directors, agents and employees; SCP Owner 1, LLC; Horton Plaza Theatres Foundation; San Diego Repertory Theatre are to be covered as additional insureds on the CGL policy with respect to liability arising out of work or operations performed by or on behalf of Contractor including materials, parts, or equipment furnished in connection with such work or operations. General liability coverage can be provided in the form of an endorsement to Contractor's insurance (at least as broad as ISO Form CG 20 10 11 85 or if not available, through the addition of both CG 20 10, CG 20 26, CG 20 33, or CG 20 38; and CG 20 37 if a later edition is used).
 - B. Primary Coverage. For any claims related to this Contract, Contractor's insurance coverage must be primary coverage at least as broad as ISO CG 20 01 04 13 as respects named insureds.
 - C. Notice of Cancellation. Each of the Contractor's insurance policies required above must provide that coverage, must not be cancelled, except with notice to named insureds.
 - D. Waiver of Subrogation. Contractor hereby grants to named insureds a waiver of any right to subrogation which the Workers' Compensation insurer of said Contractor may acquire against named insureds by virtue of the payment of any loss under such insurance. Contractor agrees to obtain any endorsement that may be necessary to affect this waiver of subrogation, but this provision applies regardless of whether or not named insureds has received a waiver of subrogation endorsement from the insurer.
- Special Risks or Circumstances. Named insureds reserves the right to modify these 6. requirements, including limits, based on the nature of the risk, prior experience, insurer, coverage, or other special circumstances.
- 7. Additional Insurance. Contractor may obtain additional insurance not required by this Contract.
- Excess Insurance. All policies providing excess coverage to named insureds must follow the form of the primary policy or policies including but not limited to all endorsements.
- Subcontractors. Contractors must require and verify that all subcontractors maintain insurance meeting all the requirements stated herein, and Contractor must ensure that named insureds is an additional insured on insurance required from subcontractors; said subcontractor shall provide certificates of insurance to the list of named insureds. For CGL coverage, subcontractors must provide coverage with a format at least as broad as the CG 20 38 04 13 endorsement.
- 10. Modification. To assure protection from and against the kind and extent of risk existing with the Contract, named insureds, at its discretion, may require the revision of amounts and coverage at any time during the term of this Contract by giving Contractor thirty (30) days prior written notice. Contractor must also obtain any additional insurance required by named insureds for new improvements, changed circumstances, or named insureds's reasonable re-evaluation of risk levels related to the Premises.
